Welcome and Introduction by Rob Crawford - Chairman

Local lettings & sales state of the market, five-minute update from Andrews – Daniel Mould, presenting a brief update on the state of the local lettings and sales market.

Property tax update - Rhys Jones, Regional Tax Director for Ince Metcalfes will be providing a property tax update, covering the latest tax changes including stamp duty land tax and the capital gains tax changes being introduced in April 2020. This will cover what planning you should be considering now, to avoid unwanted tax bills going forward.

Office of Tax Simplification (OTS) – Andy Richens who is working to simplify HMRC tax reporting and payment: the OTS is the independent adviser to the Government on tax simplification, and would like to hear from landlords on whether difficulties are experienced with the current tax reporting and payment system, and to explore the merits, difficulties or disadvantages in enabling reporting of rental income and expenses and/or payments of tax to take place more regularly than through the self-assessment system. The OTS aim to publish an initial paper on the subject in the autumn.
