Local & National issues:

- Consultation (closes 7th Nov) Bristol City Council Licensing:

 A citywide additional licensing scheme where most Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs) not already subject to mandatory licensing will need a licence.
 A selective licensing scheme in Bishopston and Ashley Down, Cotham and Easton wards where most other types of privately rented accommodation in these areas will need a licence.
- BANES Additional Licensing scheme (1280 properties) expiring on 31st Dec, no plans to renew.
- Bristol Landlord (Naomi Knapp) serves 80 possession notices.

• To reduce the administrative burden, HMO's Nationally to be classified for Council Tax purposes as single dwellings.
